



## GRAYSLAKE CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR LUNCH OPTION

### Objective

To provide our seniors with the privilege of leaving campus during their lunch period. Seniors are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior and be a positive role model. School rules apply when seniors are off campus for lunch.

### Criteria

This option is only available to students that meet the following criteria-

- Senior status with 17 or more credits
- 90% attendance
- Passing 5 classes
- No more than one suspension of three days or less.
- All student fees paid in full

Seniors must be in "good standing" with the Dean's office. **Application processing will commence on Wednesday, August 5<sup>th</sup> through Friday, August 7<sup>th</sup> from 9AM-12PM and from 1PM-3PM.** After the start of the school year, students may continue to submit their applications before/after school or during a free period.

Each student must submit a completed SLO application, (including parent signatures). **Applications are available either online or in the Dean's Office.** Seniors must purchase a non-refundable SLO identification card for \$5.00. (Replacement SLO cards may be purchased at the bookstore for \$5.00)

**\*\*All Senior Lunch Option criteria listed above will be checked on a quarterly basis\*\***

### Responsibilities

Students must remain in "good standing" with the Deans' Office by refraining from activities which generate complaints about student conduct from local businesses or community residents and from disciplinary problems on campus which may result in the temporary and/or permanent revocation of SLO privileges.

**\*\*A suspension of more than three days or multiple suspensions that total more than three days will result in the immediate revocation of SLO privileges for the remainder of the school year\*\***

Seniors may only leave/return to the building through security at the main entrance. If using any other door, student will lose SLO for a designated period of time. SLO cards will be shown to the security guard as students leave and will be left with the security guard until your return. Using any card but SLO will result in losing the card the remainder of quarter. Upon returning to campus, seniors will pick up their SLO cards from security. If you return late from SLO, your ID will be turned in to the Dean's Office and dealt with accordingly. Those leaving the building must do so promptly at the beginning of the hour and return in time for their next class.

### Consequences

Students who violate the above guidelines may have their senior lunch option privilege revoked. Once the SLO has been revoked, it cannot be reinstated for the remainder of the school year. Parents of seniors may also request that the SLO be revoked. Upon receipt of such a request, the senior's SLO privilege will be revoked immediately by the school. A parent may also have it reinstated.

**NOTE:** Any senior who leaves campus with another student without a SLO card without the school's permission will lose their SLO for the remainder of the school year. **Any senior who does not have their SLO card with them on a given day may not call parents for permission to leave. They will have to stay on campus!** If you become ill during lunch, you must still return to school & be signed out by the school nurse-no phone calls to the attendance office.
